CLUB PROGRAMS

Program One (Mighty Mites 3 on 3 League)

Grades 3-4: Program Purpose: This program is designed for skill development and scrimmage action. The Mighty Mites league runs from November to December on Saturday mornings. Parent Coaches will be needed to help run this program successfully. League sessions will consist of 30-45 minutes of station and skill work, and 30 minutes of league play. T-shirt included. **FEE: \$20**

Program Two (Traveling Teams) - Grades 3-8:

All girls that sign up will be placed on a team there are no cuts.

Program Purpose: This program is designed to provide competitive play for those girls who want to compete at a higher level. Teams will play competitive weekend tournaments in and around Central Wisconsin. Most tournaments are one day events. Teams may play 3-5 games per tournament. **There will be 2 practices a week for each team.**

Team Guidelines: 8-10 players on a team in all grades. The goal is to have more teams with fewer players which allows for more playing time. Additional coaches may be needed for grades with more than one team.

Each age group is unique and the club will make every effort to do what is in the best interest of each grade when developing teams. Teams may be evenly split or split based on individual skill level.

FEES: Grades 3-4 \$25

5-6 \$35

7-8 \$45

High School Program - Grades 9-12: This program will offer competitive opportunities. These opportunities will vary and will be decided on by the varsity coach but can include participation in fall, spring, and summer league and tournament action.
